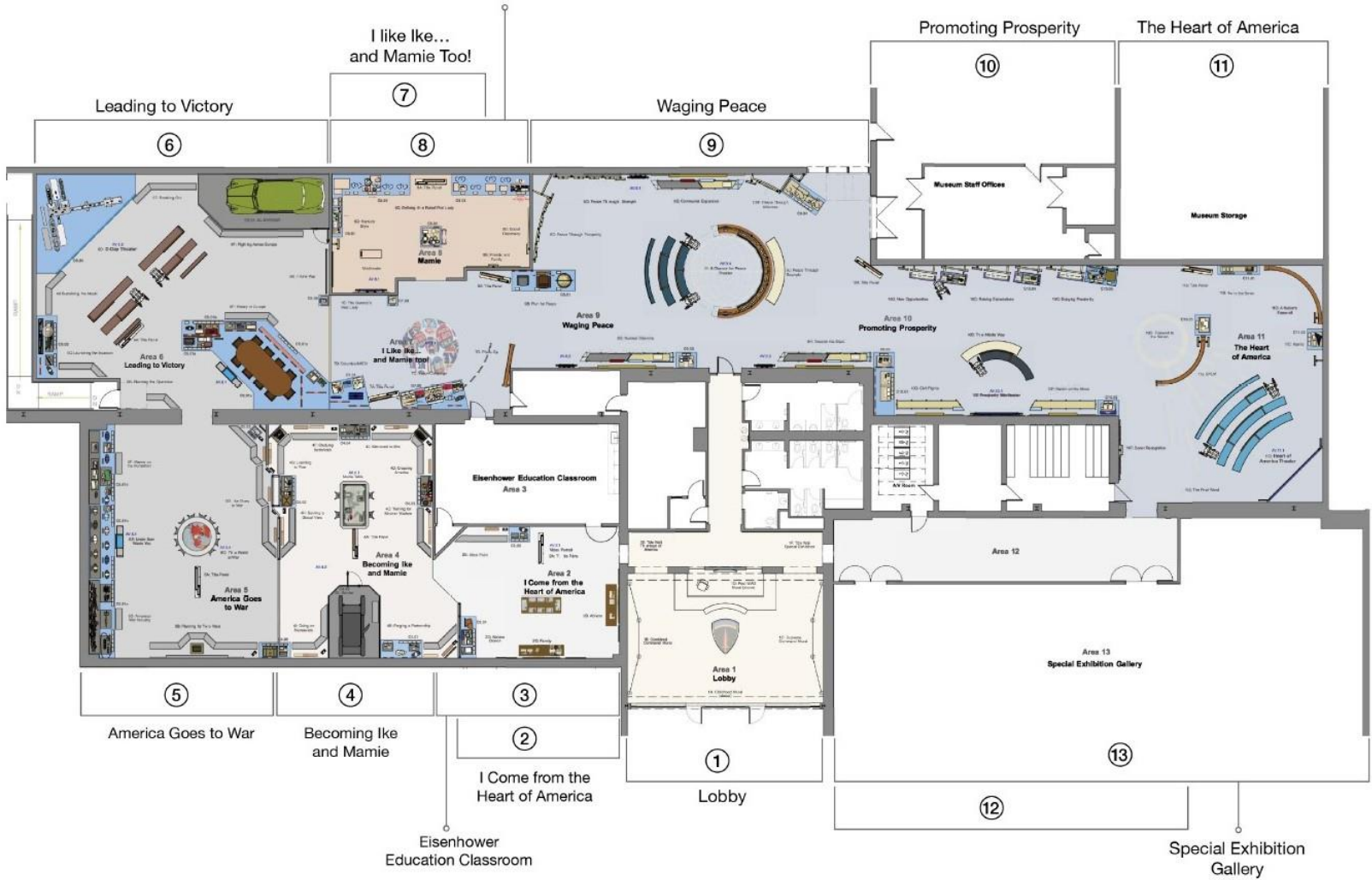

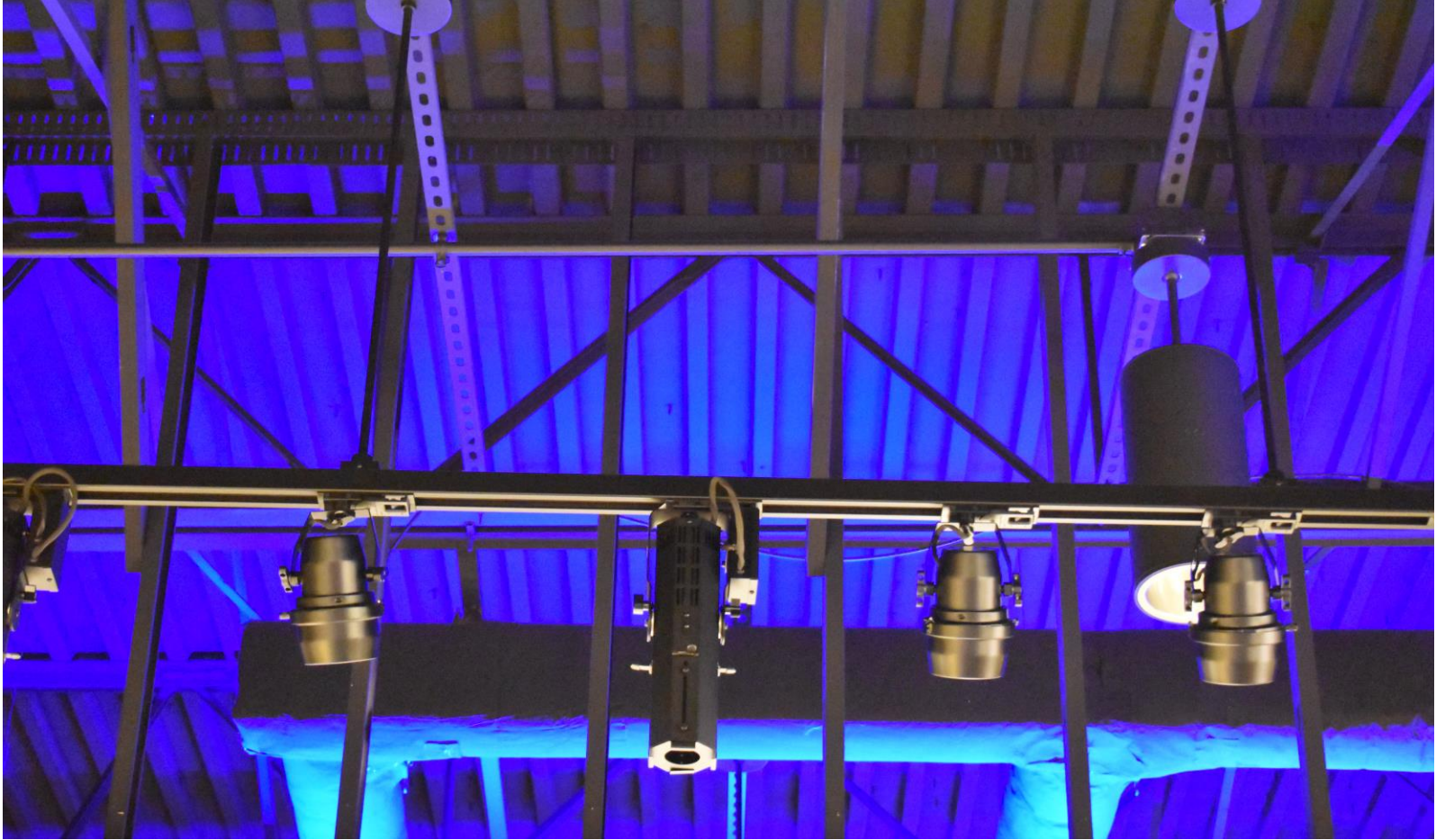

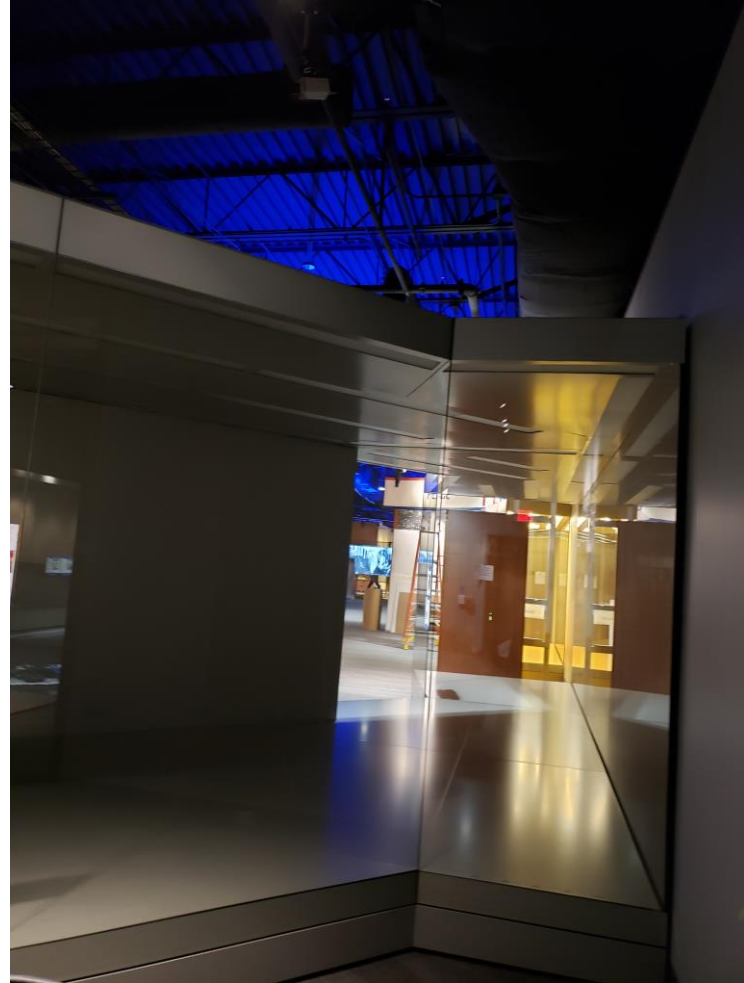






The D-Day Planning Table and 10 of the original chairs will now be on permanent display in this brand new case!

Manila, Philippines

September 1935 – December 1939

Title: Assistant Military Advisor to the Philippine Government
Rank: Major, Lieutenant Colonel (July 1, 1936)
Mentor: General Douglas MacArthur

When the United States granted independence to the Philippines, Ike was assigned to help train and equip the military. He worked under General Douglas MacArthur and became close friends with Philippine President Quezon. He realized that "a friendly Philippines was vital to U.S. interests." Mamie initially stayed behind in Washington, but when she joined Ike a few months into his posting, the couple enjoyed a lavish lifestyle and Manila's thriving social scene.

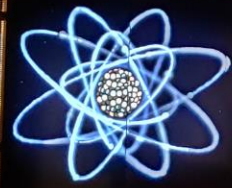






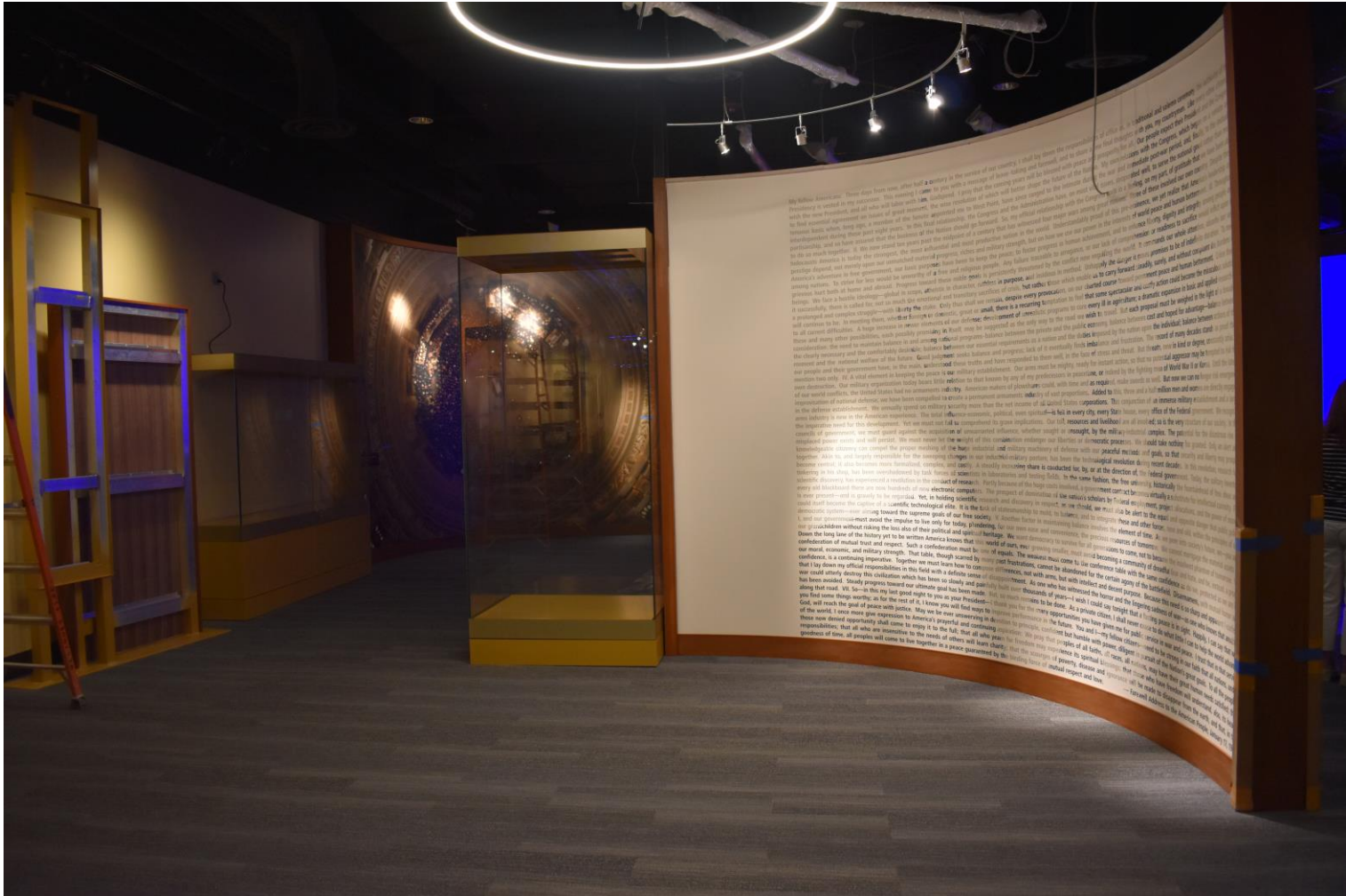

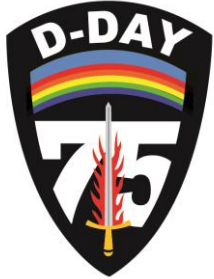
